Participating youth may be exposed to harsh weather conditions and mildly hazardous activities and conditions on water and on land (i.e. swimming, canoeing, fish processing, hiking, wildlife).

I certify that I understand the potential hazards of allowing my child to participate in Culture Camp, and release KIC from all liability resulting from any injury, illness, and/or death that may occur during Culture Camp. I further agree to hold KIC harmless from any loss, damage, or legal liability associated with activities, incidents, or occurrences related to my child’s participation in Culture Camp.

## Statement of Understanding

Travel to Culture Camp includes a 45-minute boat ride, and 2 mile hike over boardwalk and non-boardwalk remote trail. There is limited space for personal items, and youth must be able-bodied and capable of walking for long periods, navigating inclines, mild climbing while carrying a small load. Participants should bring only what they can carry in a backpack on a 2 mile trail hike in potentially rainy conditions.

I further understand that KIC will institute and enforce rules and expectations of my child throughout Culture Camp that my child will be expected to abide by. I agree to assist my child in understanding and following these rules prior to attending Culture Camp, and further agree to coordinate the pick-up of my child should it be determined that it is not safe or permissible for my child to stay at Culture Camp if persistent rule violations or behavior issues should arise that creates a disturbance, distraction, or unsafe conditions for staff and other campers.
